- (d) if not, the reasons therefor along with the reaction of the Government thereto?**

(a) to (d): There are 12 level crossings on National Highways in the State of Maharashtra as on 01.04.2016. Locations of these level crossings are as under:

As per Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between Ministry of Railways and Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) on 10.11.2014, MoRTH/National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) have to replace all level crossings on NH Corridors by Road Over Bridges (ROBs)/Road Under Bridges (RUBs) at their cost in next five years subject to availability of funds.
