(a): The details of quantum of paper used in Railways, printing presses per year, Zone-wise are as under. These are in turn used by other Zones (which do not have printing press):-

(c): Railway uses paper made as per IS 1848 wherein the pulp should be made from material containing not less than 60% other than bamboo, hard wood, soft wood and reed OR pulp should be made 100% from waste paper.

(e): Railway has started e-procurement and e-auction. This has resulted in paperless transaction in activities in which paper was required.
