- (b) the allocation made, funds utilized and remained unspent under these scheme during last three years and the current year, year and scheme-wise; and
- (c) the number of jobs generated as part of these schemes during the last three years?

- (a) : This Ministry has been implementing "Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM)" since 2014-15, after restructuring Swarna Jayanti Shahari Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY). DAY-NULM aims to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households by enabling them to

access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities for improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis.

- (b): The details of allocation made, funds utilized and funds unspent under DAY-NULM during the last three years and current year are as follows:

Year	Funds Allocated	Funds Utilized	Funds remained unspent
2013-14	777.53 crores	720.43 crores	57.10 crores
2014-15	733.00 crores	675.07 crores	57.93 crores
2015-16	261.30 crores	244.17 crores	17.13 crores

- (c) : DAY-NULM focuses on providing assistance for developing /upgrading the skill of urban poor by providing training as per the skill demand from the market, so that they can set-up self-employment ventures or secure salaried employment. Since 2013-14, 10,63,153 persons have been provided skill training and 2,16,961 beneficiaries have been assisted for setting up individual and group micro-enterprises (till 31.03.2016).
