No. 560 SHRI JAGDAMBIKA PAL:

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to build and implement a mobile and web based application to ensure timely implementation of the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) and if so, the details thereof;

(b) the time by which the application is likely to be ready for use;

(c) the details of the contents of the application and the manner in which the Government expects people using the said app to contribute to the Mission's objectives; and

(d) the funds proposed to be utilised by the Government for this purpose?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): One of the Swachh Bharat Mission(Urban) component is Scientific Management of Municipal Solid Waste. On 04.02.2016, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed with Janaagrah Centre for Citizenship and Democracy, a non-profit organisation based in Bangalore, for development and implementation of Swachh City solution. Swachh City solution will help the citizens to post complaints via a mobile app. The Swachh City solution is presently under development by Janaagrah at no cost to the government.
