(a) to (c) National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) provides financial assistance to Training Partners. Loan is one of the mode of such assistance. NSDC has disbursed soft loan to 157 training partners during last three years as under:-

During 2015-16, an amount of Rs 20 crore was released to NSDC for Skill India Campaign. A state/union territory wise list of NSDC's Operational Training Centres is given at **Annexure**.

NSDC has been mandated to set up Model Training Centers in each district of States/UTs including Bihar and Jharkhand to run industry driven courses of high quality with focus on employability and hence create an aspirational value for vocational training all across India. An amount of Rs. 75 crore has been sanctioned during 2015-16 for setting up of Model Training Centres.
