#### **GPS FOR POSTAL SERVICES**

583. SHRI SUMEDHANAND SARSWATI: SHRI OM PRAKASH YADAV:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Department of Posts has enabled the entire fleet of its mail carrying vehicles with Global Positioning System (GPS) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the number of such vehicles introduced so far, State-wise;
- (c) the funds allocated and spent in this regard till date and the target set for the same; and
- (d) the current status of National Address Database Management System?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI RAVI SHANKAR PRASAD)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Madam. The Department of Posts has installed Global Positioning System (GPS) in 990 operational Mail Motor Services(MMS) vehicles across the country. Details of the MMS vehicles fitted with GPS are at **Annexure**.
- (c) Rs.50 lakhs had been allocated for this purpose in 2015-16 of which Rs.47,15,246/have been spent till date in this regard. The target of 990 vehicles was set for fitting of GPS.
- (d) The Address Database of 67 cities across the country has been compiled and uploaded in the National Address Database Management system till date.
