**SHARING COMPETITIVE EXAM SCORES WITH PRIVATE SECTOR**

588. SHRI VINAYAK BHAURAO RAUT:  
SHRI RAHUL SHEWALE:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to share the scores obtained in recruitment examination conducted by the Government and PSUs with the private sector companies to help them hire matching talent as reported in the media;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reason behind this decision; and
- (c) the time by which the final decision is likely to be taken in this regard?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): The Government has approved the policy for public disclosure of scores and ranking of the candidates who appear for recruitment examinations conducted by various public recruitment agencies for the benefit of employers in the public and private sector seeking qualified candidates through a portal.
