**590. Shri AJAY MISRA TENI:**

**Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) the male-female child ratio in the country as per 2011 census along with the details of the figures, State-wise; and**
- (b) the details of the list of such States where the number of girl child is more than boys?**

**ANSWER**

- (a) The Office of the Registrar General of India and Census Commissioner conducts the population Census in India. As per the Census 2011, the child sex ratio (0-6 years) at all India level is 918. The State/ Union Territory wise details are given at Annexure 1.**
- (b) As per Census 2011, no State/ Union Territory of India has more number of girl children than boys (0-6 years).**
