PREFABRICATED HOUSES FOR HOMELESS

No. 634 SHRI RAJESHBHAI CHUDASAMA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any scheme to provide prefabricated houses for the homeless in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the cost of each such prefabricated house; and
- (c) the number of such houses provided to the homeless in the State of Gujarat?

ANSWER

(a): There is no separate scheme to provide prefabricated houses for homeless in the country. However, under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana -Housing for All (Urban) mission, a Technology Sub-mission has been set up to facilitate adoption of modern, innovative and green technologies and building materials for faster and quality construction of houses.

(b): The cost of prefabricated construction would vary depending upon the place of construction, type of prefab system, specification used for the building and the scale of construction.

(c): No proposal to provide prefabricated houses to the homeless has been received from the State of Gujarat.
