(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Details of new lines projects taken up by Railway with a view to connecting Pirpainti, Deoghar, Hansdiha, Godda, Vikramshila, Katuria, Pakur, Chitra and Basukinath are as under:-

1	Deoghar-Sultanganj including Banka- Barahat and Banka-Bhitiah Road (149.5 km)	2000-01	1315

3	Hansdiha-Godda (30 km)	2011-12	267
4	Pirpainti-Jasidih (97 km)	2013-14	916

In addition three more new line projects namely (i) Godda-Pakur (80 km), (ii) Chitra-Basukinath (37 km) & (iii) Vikramshila-Katareah (Pirpainti-Naugachia) (18 km) at anticipated cost of ₹1723, ₹860 & ₹1601 crores respectively have been included in Railway Budget 2016-17 subject to requisite approvals.
