GAUGE CONVERSION

†655. SHRI RAHUL KASWAN:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the work related to gauge conversion on Sadulpur-Hanumangarh section of North Western Railway has been completed and stations have been constructed in two big villages viz., Pahadsar and Shriramgarh of this area;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to construct under bridge or foot over bridge to help villagers to reach the railway station and the platform; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. Gauge conversion work of Sadulpur-Hanumangarh section has been completed. The stations at Paharsar and Shriramgarh have been constructed. Approach road to Shriramgarh has already been provided by construction of underpass whereas at Paharsar, construction of an underpass has been taken up by the state government. As both the stations are halt stations having only rail level platforms, foot over bridges have not been provided.
