Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Research Design and Standards Organisation (RDSO) has not been able to do in-house research work on various technologies required for upgradation in signalling and telecommunication system, track designing, improvement in rolling stock and many such areas and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to create a special unit, Special Railway Establishment for Strategic Technology and Holistic Advancement (SRESTHA) for conducting in-house research in Railways and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of expenditure, manpower both scientific and administrative and infrastructure likely to be required for the functioning of the new research wing of the Railways; and
- (d) the manner in which functioning of the new wing will be different from the functioning of RDSO?

ANSWER

(a): Research, Designs and Standards Organisation (RDSO) has been carrying out in-house research on technologies related to various facets of Railway working.

(b) to (d): Yes, Madam. Setting up of Special Railway Establishment for Strategic Technology & Holistic Advancement (SRESTHA), to drive long-term research on Railways has been announced as part of the budget speech of Minister for Railways for 2016-17. Implementation of the Budget item has been taken on hand including concretisation of the organisational structure, manpower requirement and manner of functioning.
