Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of States including Uttar Pradesh where the centrally sponsored Integrated City Development Planning(ICDP) has been implemented;
- (b) whether the families living below the poverty lines in urban areas are sanctioned the grants-in-aid of Rs. 1 lakh 81 thousand under this scheme and whether the house constructed with the said amount is sufficient for a family to live in;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to increase the said amount to Rs. 4 lakh in view of the rise in the construction cost; and
- (d) if so, the time by which it is likely to be done?
