(a) & (b): National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) proposes to set up a 4000 MW Thermal Power Project at Lalam Koduru (erstwhile Pudimadaka) in Vishakhapatnam Dist. in Andhra Pradesh. Feasibility Report of the Project has been approved on 28.11.2014. Further, NTPC is constructing 250 MW Solar PV Project at Ananthapur under Green Energy commitment to Government of India. In addition, Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) for the another 750 MW Solar PV Project at Ananthapur was issued on 21.08.2015.
