**VADODARA-MUMBAI HIGHWAY**

709. SHRI DILIP PATEL:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposals from the Government of Gujarat for joining Ahmedabad-Vadodara National Highway with the newly approved Vadodara-Mumbai Express Way;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the status of preparation of feasibility report for the project; and
- (c) whether any timeframe has been fixed to join these two parts of the National Highways and if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Ahmedabad – Vadodara section of National Highway No-8 has already been constructed. Vadodara to Mumbai corridor has been selected for upgradation to Expressway. Feasibility study of this corridor has already been approved under NHDP-VI. Time frame for construction of Vadodara-Mumbai Expressway cannot be indicated at this stage. Ahmedabad-Vadodara National Highway No-8 is to be connected with the Vadodara-Mumbai Express way after construction.
