- (a) whether the Coal India Limited (CIL) has decided to implement an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system that will help it monitor and optimize performance on a real time basis and save money as the company targets production of 1 billion tonnes by 2019-2020;
- (b) if so, whether the CIL will save Rs.1000 crore every year on better resource and inventory management once the ERP system is fully implemented;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the advantages of an ERP system for CIL would include improved revenue and financial management, introduction to International Financial Reporting Standards based accounting, optimization of coal production and its movement by rail, road and other modes of transport, sampling, reduction in spare parts inventory and breakdown maintenance, improved governance, regulatory and environmental compliance, enhanced manpower productivity and innovation; and
