**FUNDS UNDER IAY**

**750. SHRI VIJAY KUMAR HANSDAK:**

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether funds meant for the construction of houses for poor in Jharkhand under the Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) have been slashed;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the funds allocated to Jharkhand under the Indira Awas Yojana during the last three years?

**ANSWER**

(a) and (b) : The funds under the IAY scheme are allocated to the States and physical targets fixed in accordance with a pre-determined criteria assigning 75% weightage to the housing shortage as per the latest Census data and 25% weightage to the poverty ratio uniformly to all the States across the country. Till the year 2013-14, the housing shortage comprising shelterless households and the number of unserviceable houses as per Census 2001 was taken into account. From the year 2014-15, data of census 2011 has been taken for fixation of physical targets accordingly the number of shelterless households and number of dilapidated houses has been taken into account.

(c) : The detail of funds allocated to Jharkhand under the Indira Awaas Yojana during last three years is given as under:
