- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct six lane road from Malakapur to Akola sectors of National Highway No. 6;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether there are several potholes and road is damaged at several places on the said sections; and
- (e) the reaction of the Government thereto and the reasons for not holding any officer responsible for the condition of road?

The stretch of Amravati- Dhule-Gujarat Border section of NH-6, which includes stretch from Malkapur to Akola, has been approved for upgradation to four laning under NHDP-Phase IV. The stretch of Amravati to Chikhali from Km 166 to Km 360, which includes stretch from Malkapur to Akola, has already been awarded for upgradation to 4-laning and Concession Agreement has been signed on 08.09.2015 and the work will start shortly after declaration of appointed date.

(d) & (e) No Madam. The existing 2-lane Carriageway has been maintained pot hole free by NHAI
