**SUB-STANDARD MATERIAL USED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NH-26**

- (a) whether the Government is aware that sub standard material has been used in construction of North-South corridor of NH-26;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any monitoring is being done through sample-checking etc. to ensure the quality of the construction; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (b) Jhansi–Lalitpur-Sagar - Rajmarg Chauraha – Lakhnadon stretch of NH-26 is a part of North-South Corridor. The work has been completed prior to 2013 and is now under Operation & Maintenance. There is no complaint reported for using sub- standard material on these stretch.

(c) and (d) Yes Madam. Testing/checking of construction material is carried out by Independent Engineer/ Supervision Consultant to ensure the quality of the construction as per provision of Contract Agreement.

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
