a) to (e): In the Budget speech the Hon'ble Finance Minister has announced the revival of the unserved and underserved airports at an indicative cost of Rs 50-100 crore per airport, in partnership with State Governments to develop such airports for regional connectivity. The revival includes 10 out of the 25 non-functional airports of Airport Authority of India, based on demand from airline operators.
