Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from the Government of Maharashtra relating to Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the present status of the said proposal; and
- (d) the time by which the said proposal is likely to be cleared along with the reasons for delay, if any?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER & SANITATION (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a) to (d) Government of Maharashtra has submitted Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) for 2016-17. In the AIP-2016-17, State has proposed requirement of Rs. 1422.76 crore as central share. State has proposed construction of 15.53 lakh Individual Household latrines in the year 2016-17. Tentatively Rs. 528.94 crore have been allocated to Maharashtra under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin). However the actual releases during the year 2016-2017 would be subject to progress of State and availability of resources.
