SKILL TRAINING IN TEXTILE SECTOR

909. SHRIMATI V. SATHYA BAMA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to impart skill training to people in textiles, ready-made garments, knitwear industries etc.;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the total amount allocated and spent, during each of the last three years, State-wise;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to facilitate both financial and logistic support to textiles and knitwear industries in Tamil Nadu; and
- (d) the various Central assistance schemes initiated in last two years for the benefit of textiles and knitwear industries in the country?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam, With a view to address the skilled manpower needs of the textile & related industry including ready-made garments and knitwear, Ministry of Textiles is implementing Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) to train 15 lakh persons during 12th Five Year Plan. Under the Scheme, the Government provides assistance up to 75% of the total project cost subject to a ceiling limit of Rs. 10,000/- per trainee. The scheme is being implemented pan India through institutions of Ministry, Private Industry Partners and State Government Agencies/institutions. The funds under ISDS are released directly to Implementing Agencies to conduct the training programme in the States as per the Detailed Project Report. Year wise budget allocation and expenditure under ISDS during last three years is as follows:-

(c): With a view to support the textiles industries in Tamil Nadu, the Ministry has so far sanctioned nine Textile Parks under the Scheme for Integrated Textile Park. During last two years the Ministry has sanctioned additional grant of Rs.10 Crores to Palladam Hi tech Weaving Park to set up three new apparel units in the textile Park. The Ministry has sanctioned a worker hostel to the Palladam Hi Tech Weaving Park with Government of India Grant of Rs. 3.00 crores under the “Scheme for Textile Worker’s Accommodation”. The Ministry has also sanctioned a new Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) with Zero Liquid Discharge at Southern District Textile Processing Cluster at Kariapatti, Virudhunagar District.

(d): Details of various Central assistance schemes initiated in the last two years for the benefit of textiles and knitwear industries is as follows:-
