Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has introduced interest free banking also known as Islamic Banking in India; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the salient features of the said banks?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JAYANT SINHA)

- (a): No, Sir. Government has not introduced Interest Free Banking.
- (b): In view of (a) above, Question does not arise.
