# PLASTIC/SYNTHETIC RICE

#### 994. SHRI DEVAJIBHAI G. FATEPARA:

#### Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has taken note of presence of imported plastic/ synthetic rice in the country during the last three years;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise and the action taken against the erring Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) officials for clearing such adulterated food consignments; and

(c) the corrective steps taken by the Government to prevent the import of adulterated food items?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI JAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(a): The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has informed that on the basis of International Food Safety Authorities Network (INFOSAN) alert received on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2015, the matter was taken up by the FSSAI with various State Governments. As per data available in the Food Import Clearance System (FICS), no import of plastic/synthetic rice has been noticed during last three years. The State Governments have also informed that no incidence of imported plastic rice has been reported in their respective states.
