***110. SHRI J.J.T. NATTERJEE:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of development of Ramayana, Buddha, Sufi and Krishna Tourist Circuits in the country;**
- (b) whether the Government proposes to develop Ramayana, Buddha, Sufi and Krishna tourist circuits in the country under the swadesh darshan scheme;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the destinations identified in different States under this scheme;**
- (d) the funds allocated/sanctioned for the development of the destinations in the proposed tourist circuits; and**
- (e) whether the Government has made any agreement for including Sri Lanka in the Ramayana Tourist Circuit and if so, the details thereof?**

STATEMENT IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*110 ANSWERED ON 25.07.2016 REGARDING RAMAYANA AND KRISHNA CIRCUITS.

(a): The Ministry of Tourism has launched the Swadesh Darshan scheme for integrated development of theme based tourist circuits in the country in 2014-15. Ramayana, Krishna, Buddhist and Spiritual Circuits are among the thirteen thematic circuits identified for development under the scheme. Sufi Circuit has not been identified as a thematic circuit for development under the scheme however, places related to Sufism are covered under the Spiritual Circuit theme.

(b): The destinations initially identified for development under the Ramayana, Krishna and Buddhist Circuits in the country are as under:

- Ramayana Circuit: Ayodhya, Nandigram, Shringverpur & Chitrakoot (Uttar Pradesh); Sitamarhi, Buxar & Darbhanga (Bihar); Chitrakoot (Madhya Pradesh); Mahendragiri (Odisha); Jagdalpur (Chattisgarh); Nashik & Nagpur (Maharashtra); Bhadrachalam (Telangana); Hampi (Karnataka) and Rameshwaram (Tamil Nadu).**
- Buddhist Circuit: All places associated with the Buddhist heritage in the country.**
- Krishna Circuit: Dwarka (Gujarat); Nathdwara, Jaipur & Sikar (Rajasthan); Kurukshetra (Haryana), Mathura, Vrindavan, Gokul, Barsana, Nandgaon & Govardhan (Uttar Pradesh) and Puri (Odisha).**

(c) & (d): The details of funds sanctioned for the development of the destinations in the proposed tourist circuits are as follows:
