**RESTORATION OF WATER BODIES**

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of old water resources revived under the repair, restoration and renovation scheme of the Government in view of the shortage of water resources in various States particularly in Rajasthan;
- (b) the names of the water resources proposed to be repaired/restored in future; and
- (c) whether a number of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) are pending for approval under this scheme and if so, the time by which such approval is likely to be granted?

**Statement Referred to in Reply of para (a) to (c) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. \*177 for answer on 28.07.2016 regarding “Restoration of Water Bodies”**

(a) Water Resources Projects are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priority. In order to supplement the efforts of the State Governments, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes and programmes such as Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP); and scheme of Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of water bodies etc.

Under RRR of Water Bodies scheme, a total of 11865 old water bodies have been revived including 26 water bodies in the State of Rajasthan. The State-wise details are given at Annexure-I.

(b) & (c) During XII Plan, Proposals for 3739 water bodies have been received from various States for their inclusion under RRR scheme. Out of these, 1354 water bodies for which Detailed Project Report (DPR) have been submitted by the concerned State Government as per the guidelines of the schemes, have been included for funding under this scheme. State-wise details of these water bodies are given at Annexure-II.

In respect of proposals for the balance 2385 water bodies, CWC has made certain observations. The compliance for the same has not been received from concerned State Governments. The time taken for approval for inclusion of projects under RRR scheme depends upon the time taken by the concerned State Governments to formulate the proposal as per guidelines.
