(a) & (b) Yes, Madam.

The Festival was organized under the aegis of the Scheme for “Conducting Festivals of India (Fol) Abroad” from 17-19 June 2016. The main objectives of the Scheme are:

- (i) Promote Indian culture abroad.
- (ii) Strengthen bonds of foreign countries with India.
- (iii) Promote bilateral cultural contacts.
- (iv) Project India’s cultural image abroad.
- (v) Promote Indian artists abroad.
- (vi) Promote inbound tourism.

(c) Ministry of Culture has, so far, released a sum of Rs.1,27,91,945/- (which is 75% of the total approved expenditure of Rs.1,70,55,927/-) to organise Ganges-Danube Cultural Festival of India in Hungary.

(d) & (e) Yes, Madam.

In order to promote Indian Culture in the world, Festivals of India are organized in various countries in which art and culture is projected through dance and music performances, exhibitions, food festival, literary festival, film festival, Yoga, Mehendi art etc.

The Festivals of India abroad are currently ongoing in Myanmar and Spain.
