School of Archival Studies of National Archives of India does not have any other branch in the country. Ministry of Culture or the National Archives of India does of India does not collect information in regard to the State-wise and place-wise names of Schools of Archival Studies, if any, currently running in the country.

(b) There is no such proposal under consideration of National Archives of India, Ministry of Culture.

(c) Not applicable in view of (b) above.

(d) Most of the State Governments have their own State Archives and if they so decide, they can set up School of Archival Studies in their States.
