- (a) whether the insurgent/extremist groups in the North Eastern Region are reportedly getting external support from neighbouring countries and if so, the details thereof including financial and other assistance;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that the National Socialists Council of Nagaland (Khaplang) is acting at the behest of neighbouring countries and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the follow up action taken by the Government thereon?

(a) to (c): While there is intelligence that Indian Insurgent Groups (IIGs) have established their camps, shelter houses and training centres across the border in neighbouring countries of North Eastern Region, there is no specific information that National Socialists Council of Nagaland (Khaplang) is acting at the behest of neighbouring countries.

The Central Government has taken various steps for keeping close vigil on the international borders by way of deployment of Security Forces and equipping them with modern equipments, erection of fencing, installation of floodlights, strengthening of riverine patrolling etc. The neighbouring countries have been urged to take stern action against the leaders of IIGs and dismantle their safe houses/hideouts in their country.
