STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (D) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 347 TO BE ANSWERED ON 10.08.2016 ASKED BY SHRI K.PARASURAMAN AND SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN REGARDING 'NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP PROMOTION SCHEME'

(a) The Government of India has approved 'National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme' with an indicative outlay of Rs. 10,000 crore to provide apprenticeship training to 50 lakh youth by 2020. Under the scheme, Government of India will share 25% of prescribed stipend subject to a maximum of Rs. 1500 per month per apprentice with the employers. Government of India will also share maximum Rs. 7500 per fresher apprentice (without any formal trade training) as a cost of basic training with Basic Training Providers for a maximum duration of 500 hours/3 months.
