- (a) whether rail wheels presently produced in the country are being sent to United States for its testing;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the amount incurred for wheel testing in USA;**
- (c) whether the Rail India Technical and Economic Service (RITES) has initiated the work for setting up of country's first design development and testing centre;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the place/city identified to set up the proposed centre; and**
- (e) the amount earmarked and allocated during this financial year and the time by which the proposed testing centre is likely to be operational?**

REGARDING RAIL WHEEL TESTING CENTRE**

- (a) Only wheels developed to new designs by Rail Wheel Factory (RWF), Bengaluru, are sent to Transportation Technology Corporation Inc. (TTCI)/USA for design validation and performance review.**
- (b) So far, three types of cast wheels have been sent by RWF for testing to TTCI/USA at a total cost of ₹ 5.13 crores.**
- (c) Yes, Madam. Work has been assigned to Rail India Technical and Economic Service (RITES) in March, 2016.**
- (d) The proposed Design, Development and Testing Centre has been sanctioned at an estimated cost of ₹ 57.75 crores, at Rail Wheel Factory, Yelahanka, Bengaluru.**
- (e) ₹ 1 crore has been earmarked and allocated during the current year. The project duration is approx. 36 months.**
