- (a) the details of new National Highways (NHs) constructed during the last three years, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has set a target of 11490 kms. of NH for the year 2016-17, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the target of the Government for construction of NHs in the next five years; and
- (d) the steps taken to actively involve the State Governments in the construction of NHs?

- (a) The National Highways (NHs) constructed during the last three years 2013-14, 2014-15 & 2015-16 are 4260, 4410 & 6062 km and state-wise details are given at Annexure-I.
- (b) The existing NH length is 103519 km & nearly 42725 km has been approved in principle subject to the outcome of DPRs. The Length under different schemes which is targeted for completion in next five years are :

- (c) and (d) Targets for construction are generally finalized on year to year basis. The targets finalized for the current financial year 2016-17 as 15000 km and details are given at Annexure-II. The public works department of state governments are involved in execution of the work on national highways entrusted to them. In addition the state government assist as the following:
 - (i) The land acquisition for highway projects is done with the help of State Governments as the competent authorities and the arbitrators under the NH Act are State Government officials.
 - (ii) The state government officials are involved in forest clearances, public utility shifting, etc.
 - (iii) Strengthening the infrastructure and manpower resources are done with the help of State Governments.
