**Statement to be laid on the table of the Lok Sabha in reply to Starred question No. 68 dated 21.07.2016 regarding "Manpower Requirement in Aviation Sector".**

**(a): As per a recent study conducted by Ministry of Civil Aviation, based on the trends witnessed in various sectors that the industry would provide direct employment of about one million persons by 2035.**

**(b) to (d): The employment details of trained manpower in the Aviation Sector is not maintained by Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA). However, 47 DGCA-approved Aircraft Maintenance Engineering (AME) institutes can admit about 2400 students per year and till now, DGCA has issued licences to 13433 personnel, which includes type rated licence and basic licence. Employment in the sector is industry-driven. However, this Ministry together with the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship has constituted an Aerospace & Aviation Sector Skill Council (AASSC) under the National Skill Development Authority (NSDA) with the mandate to develop 70 Job Roles in aerospace and aviation sector.**
