# LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 92 TO BE ANSWERED ON THE 22<sup>ND</sup> JULY, 2016 MISSION INDRADHANUSH

### \*92. SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE: PROF. PREM SINGH CHANDUMAJRA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the extent to which the aims and objectives of Mission Indradhanush achieved along with the number of children and pregnant women covered under the mission, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the number of districts covered so far and the districts likely to be covered under the mission across the country, State/ UT-wise;
- (c) whether the cases of death of children and pregnant women after vaccination under the mission have come to the notice of the Government since inception of the mission; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise and the reasons thereofor along with the reaction of the Government thereto?

### STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 92\* FOR 22<sup>ND</sup> JULY, 2016

- (a) Mission Indradhanush aims to increase full immunization coverage in India to atleast 90% children by 2020. Till June 2016, the mission has covered 195.5 lakh children and 51.1 lakh pregnant women. State/UT-wise list of children covered under the mission is given in Annexure 1.
- (b) Till date, Mission Indradhanush has covered 497 districts across 35 State/UTs. The State/UT-wise details of the number of districts covered are given in Annexure 1.
- (c) & (d) As part of the Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) surveillance and monitoring system, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare constantly monitors the programme and after active analysis of Mission Indradhanush reports, it was found that deaths of 27 children were reported during the period of Mission Indradhanush. However, the preliminary investigations do not suggest any relationship of the reported deaths with the vaccines administered during the period of Mission Indradhanush. The state wise detail of all these deaths is given as Annexure 2. No death has been reported in pregnant women during the period of Mission Indradhanush.
