- (a) Whether the Government has constituted any Committee to explore the possibilities for establishment of Indian Education Service (IES);
- (b) If so, whether the said Committee has also submitted its recommendations in this regard;
- (c) If so, the details thereof and the salient features of recommendations; and
- (d) The follow-up actions proposed by the Government on the recommendations of the Committee?

(a) to (d): National Education Policies of 1968 and 1986 (modified in 1992) provide for formation of Indian Education Service as an All India Service. However, there was no consensus among the State Governments and as such the proposal was dropped. The Committee constituted for Evolution of the New Education Policy has comprehensively examined the matter and recommended for the establishment of Indian Education Service. Recommendation of the Committee has been incorporated in Some Inputs for Draft National Education Policy, 2016 which is available at MHRD's website.
