- (c) whether the Union Government proposes to strengthen the coastal security of the country with the support of a French company, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Union Government has taken up the matter with various stakeholders, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the response of such stakeholders received by the Union Government thereto?

All coastal State Governments have been requested to convey their firm commitment for preserving Aircraft Carrier INS Viraat and converting into 'Aircraft Carrier Museum' post decommissioning. Some of these States have responded and requested for further information / clarification.
