## NURSE PRACTITIONER COURSES

#### 1011. SHRI JOSE K. MANI:

#### Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has recently launched two new nurse practitioner courses and a web-based live register of nursing staff to ensure optimum usage of trained manpower;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the system and method of web-based live register of nursing staff; and

(c) whether two new nursing practitioner courses provide any job guarantee after their successful completion, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

(a) & (b): Government has recently launched one course, Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care. A web based Live Registrar for nurses has also been launched which will help Nurses in primary registration; updating their qualification; reciprocal registration (i.e. migration to other states); etc.

(c): Nurse Practitioners in Critical Care will provide opportunity for nurse to work in tertiary care and multispeciality hospital
