USE OF TECHNOLOGY BY IT OFFICIALS

1017. SHRI D.K. SURESH:

Will the Minister of **FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Income Tax officials make use of information technology effectively in their functioning, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether digitization is at very slow pace in the Income Tax Department and if so, the reasons therefor, and
- (c) The effective steps taken or proposed to be taken to ensure maximum digitization of income tax department?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) The Income-tax Department has leveraged technology to develop responsive, efficient, effective & transparent tax administration.

The important area of such initiatives includes :-

(i) Allotment of Permanent Account Number [PAN] and Tax (Deduction & Collection) Account Number [TAN].

(ii) Facility for payment of Taxes online and through ATMs of designated banks,

(iii) e-filing of Income-tax Returns with facility of e-verification.

(iv) Processing of returns at Centralised Processing Centre-Income Tax Return (CPC-ITR), Bangalore.

(v) Processing of TDS statements in CPC-TDS.

(vi) Online Generation of Annual Tax Credit Statement (Form 26AS).

(vii) Credit of Refunds upto a threshold directly in bank account of taxpayers.

(viii) Computer aided selection of cases for scrutiny (CASS) based on data collected by the Department.

(ix) Non filer monitoring system based on data of high value transactions, to widen the tax net.

(x) e-Sahayog : To provide an online mechanism to resolve mismatches in Income-tax returns without requiring taxpayers to attend the Income-tax office.

(xi) e-assessment : E-Assessment project aims to usher in paperless environment while carrying out regular assessment of scrutiny cases selected under CASS. On pilot basis, it has been implemented in select non-corporate charges of 7 major cities.

(xii) Maintenance of national website www.incometaxindia.gov.in which is a rich repository for the benefit of Departmental personnel & taxpayer.

(b) The digitization process of Income Tax Department is an ongoing process.

(c) Various Modules of Income Tax Business Application (ITBA) and Project Insight (Data Warehousing & Business Intelligence) are at various stages of implementation.
