## 1055. SHRI NISHIKANT DUBEY: SHRI ARVIND SAWANT:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of medical colleges in the country along with the total number of medical seats available, States/UT-wise;
- (b) whether there is any reservation of seats for Non-Resident Indians (NRIs), under Management Quota in the self finance colleges in the States;
- (c) if so, the details thereof including the reservation policy for SCs, STs, OBCs and BPL families being followed by these medical colleges; and
- (d) the details of fee structure for student admitted in Government and private colleges?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

- (a): As on date, there are total 59883 MBBS seats in 439 Medical Colleges in India. The States/UT-wise details are Annexed.
- (b) to (d): As per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the private medical colleges in India are permitted to fill up to 15% of management quota in MBBS course under NRI Quota. The reservation for SCs/STs/OBCs category candidates is followed in Government Medical Colleges.

In the case of Government medical colleges, the respective State Governments are responsible for fixation of fees. However, in the case of private unaided medical colleges, the fee structure is decided by the Committee set up by the respective State Government under the Chairmanship of a retired High Court Judge in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. It is for the Committee to decide whether the fee proposed by an Institute is justified and the fee fixed by the Committee is binding on the Institute.
