QUESTION

1062. SHRI LALLU SINGH

Will the **Minister of FINANCE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the burden per year for implementing recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission for pay rise and increase in efficiency and improvement in productivity as a result thereof;
- (b) Whether the Government proposes to fix the responsibility of Government employees and rules for action if found lacking in performing their duties;
- (c) Whether the Government proposes to formulate a national income policy which will contemplate to increase in the pay scales of employees of Government and private sector; and
- (d) If so, the details thereof and if not, the details of steps taken to increase the income of general public?

ANSWER

- (a) The additional financial impact of ₹ 84,933 crore is estimated because of revision of pay and pension as accepted by the Government. This includes arrears of two months of 2015-16.
- (b) The existing service rules already enjoin upon the Government employees to perform their duties in a responsible manner.
- (c) & (d): No such proposal is under consideration of the Government.
