(a) & (b): Indian Institute of Management Sambalpur has been established and started its academic session for 2015-16 from its transit campus at Silicon Institute of Technology (SIT), which is a private institute in the State of Odisha. A part of the campus has been taken on rent to run the Indian Institute of Management Sambalpur. The Transit Campus is equipped with all the required infrastructure like class rooms, office rooms, hostel, playground, internet, library, mess etc.

The in-house facilities like Computer room, Video-conferencing room, guest room, and band-width are also available in the Campus. Possession of land for permanent campus of the institute has been taken over. The State Government of Odisha has agreed to make boundary wall, 2.5 Kilometer road connectivity and cooperate in extending telephone facility and band width facility to the permanent campus.

(c): The process of construction of boundary wall of the permanent campus site allotted by the State Government has already been initiated. The Ministry of Human Resource Development has released an amount of Rs. 10 crore and Rs. 5 crore to Indian Institute of Management Indore, the mentor institute of Indian Institute of Management Sambalpur during the year 2015-16 and 2016-17 (as on 30.06.2016) respectively.
