(a) to (c) Yes Madam. A portal has been created at <http://eacharya.inflibnet.ac.in> where study material for colleges and professional courses prepared by various Institutes under National Mission on Education through Information & Communication Technology has been uploaded. The portal provides facility to search and browse all hosted content wherein a learner can easily access the desired material including audio/video learning material, textual material, multimedia enriched materials etc. through a single interface.

Under e-Pathsala initiative for school education, the National Council of Educational Research and Training has digitalized all its text books and has made them available on its website i.e. ncert.nic.in and also through e-pathsala.nic.in which is also accessible through all mobile devices. The collection include textbooks for Class I to Class XII in English, Hindi and Urdu versions converted into e-pub-3.0 format and made available with an exclusive license for free download and dissemination.
