Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated and utilised under Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the steps taken to improve quality education at the secondary level in the country; and
- (c) the fund released and utilised under Mid-Day Meal during the last three years, State/UT-wise?

- (a) : State/UT-wise details of funds allocated and utilized during the last three years and the current year under Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) are given at Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively.
- (b) : The Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) envisages enhancing the quality of education by providing a Secondary School within a reasonable distance of every habitation, and removal of gender, socio-economic and disability barriers. The scheme provides for financial assistance for classrooms, science laboratory, library, computer room, art/craft/culture room, toilets, drinking water facilities etc. in new/upgraded and existing secondary schools. Further, salary of teachers, in-service teacher training, training of Master Trainers and Key Resource Persons, induction training of Teachers, Leadership training of Headmasters/Principals & State Resource Groups (SRGs), ICT scheme etc. are also supported for improving standards of secondary education.
- (c) : State/UT-wise fund released and utilized under Mid Day Meal during the last three years is given at Annexure-III.
