LITERACY RATE AMONG TRIBAL

1266.SHRI Y.V. SUBBA REDDY:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRSbe pleased to state:

(a) the present literacy rate among theScheduled Tribes (STs) indicating the break-up of male and female literacy rates and its comparison vis-à-vis the overall literacy rate in the country, State/UT-wise includingAndhra Pradesh;

(b) whether the Government is satisfied with the present improvement of the literacy rate of tribals and if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto;

(c) the details of the schemes beingimplemented by Government and achievements therefrom to improve the literacy level of STs along with the financial assistance released and utilized thereunderduring each of the last three years and the current year, Scheme and State/UT-wise including Andhra Pradesh; and

(d) the other steps taken/being takenby the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JASWANTSINH SUMANBHAI BHABHOR)

(a): State / UT wise literacy rates among the Scheduled Tribes (STs) indicating the break- up of male and female literacy rates and its comparison vis-à-vis the overall literacy rate in the country, including Andhra Pradesh, as per Census 2011 is given at **Annexure I.**

(b) &(c): Literacy rate in respect of Scheduled Tribes has improved from 47% in 2001 (Census 2001) to 59 % in 2011 (Census 2011). However, there is still a gap of 14% as compared to literacy rate of total population as per Census 2011.

Ministry of Tribal Affairs supplements the efforts of the Ministry of Human Resources Development, which is the line Ministry with regard to the subject of education, and the State Governments/UT Administrations by administering various schemes with the objective of enhancing access to education through provision of infrastructure by way of construction of hostels for ST students, Establishment of Ashram Schools, Vocational Training Centres as well as to maximize retention of ST students within the various stages of school education and promoting higher learning by providing monetary incentives in the form of scholarships such as Pre Matric Scholarship, Post Matric Scholarship (PMS), Scholarship for Top Class Education, Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship and National Overseas Scholarship for ST students.Ministry alsoimplements a scheme, namely, Strengthening Education among Scheduled Tribe Girls in Low Literacy Districts for educational upliftment of ST girls.

Scheme wise details of funds released and utilized thereunder during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise, including Andhra Pradesh, are given at **Annexures II to IX**.

(d): Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is a Government of India flagship programme for achievement of Universalization of Elementary Education (UEE) in a time bound manner, making free and compulsory education to children of 6-14 years age group, including ST children.Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) and a special program for residential schools for girls, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya are also important schemes being implemented by Ministry of Human Resource Development.
