(a)& (b) Green Climate Fund (GCF) has been set up under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) as an operating entity of financial mechanism of the Convention. There is no specific allocation of funds for individual countries and the funds are allocated directly by the GCF.
