(a) whether it is true that the economic survey has favoured use of hybrid and genetically modified seeds to increase the agricultural productivity since there is limited scope for increasing acreage; and

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto?

(a): Economic survey 2015-16 has stated that "the adoption of Hybrid and High Yielding Varieties (HYVs) seeds is one definite pathway to raising productivity in Indian Agriculture".

(b): Government is open to all technologies, including GM technologies that are useful for our farmers subject to conformity with our environmental laws and regulations. Hybrid technology in Maize, Sorghum, Bajara, Sunflower, Castor, Cotton & Rice and GM technology in cotton, as well as HYVs in all crops, have already been widely adopted in the country.
