SPONGE IRON PLANTS

146. SHRI GOPAL SHETTY:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of private and public sector sponge iron plants operating in the country at present, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of employment opportunities created in these plants;
- (c) whether any provision has been made for providing certain percentage of jobs to the local people in the said plants; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken so far in this regard?

ANSWER

- (a) The number of private and public sector sponge iron plants in the country during 2015-16 is given at **Annexure 1**.
- (b) As per a survey conducted by the Joint Plant Committee (JPC) in 2012-13, total employment in the domestic sponge iron market stood at 1,15,927 during the said year. State-wise details are shown in **Annexure -2**.
- (c)&(d): Steel being a deregulated sector, the role of Government is limited to that of a facilitator to provide a conducive policy environment for sustained growth and competitive development of the industry. Specific decisions on recruitment of employees in private steel sector are taken by individual steel companies/investors on the basis of their requirement. In the case of CPSUs, recruitment is based on Government guidelines.
