(d): The number of combing operations done by security forces (Central Armed Police Forces) during the last three years, border-wise are given below:

S.No.	Border	Combing Operations by security forces during last three years (2013, 2014 & 2015)
1	Indo-Bangladesh Border	Regular patrolling is done by BSF
2	Indo-Pakistan Border	Combing Operations are done on daily basis by BSF
3	Indo-China Border	No Combing Operations were conducted along Indo-China border.
4	Indo-Nepal Border	Routine border patrolling is done by SSB
5	Indo-Bhutan Border	Routine border patrolling is done by SSB
6	Indo-Myanmar Border	Combing Operations are done on regular basis by Assam Rifles
