Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any targets were fixed for the procurement of wheat during the current season;
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the targeted and actual total procurement as well as the decline in procurement as compared to the previous Rabi season:
- (c) whether the Government has formulated any policy to meet any shortage and price rise of wheat in view of lower production and procurement; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Madam. The targets/estimate for procurement of wheat were fixed by Government of India (GOI) in consultation with State Government before the commencement of Rabi Marketing Season (RMS).
- (b) The estimated/targeted and actual procurement of wheat during previous Rabi marketing season and current Rabi marketing season is as under :

The average annual offtake of wheat has been 231.74 lakh MT during last three years (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16) under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS)/ National Food Security Act (NFSA) and Other Welfare Scheme (OWS). Thus there is no shortage of wheat in the Central Pool.

In order to contain price rise of wheat Food Corporation of India (FCI) sales wheat under Open market Sales Scheme (OMSS) (Domestic). 8.81 LMT wheat was sold under OMSS(D) as on 22.07.2016
