(a) The India Statistical Strengthening Project (ISSP) now renamed as Support for Statistical Strengthening (SSS) aims at improving the statistical capacity and infrastructure of State Statistical Systems for collecting, compiling and disseminating reliable official statistics for policy planning at the State and Sub-State levels. The approved outlay for the scheme is Rs. 650.43 crore. The scheme is being currently implemented in 16 States. (b) & (c) For the 16 currently implementing States, the project is at different stages of implementation. The details of funds allocated, and major achievements as reported by States are at Annexure.
